The Department of Social and Emotional Learning will host Classroom Management training for classroom teachers. CHAMPS is tailored to preK-8 teachers while Discipline in Secondary Classrooms (DSC) is tailored to 9-12 grade teachers. Participants will gain an understanding of the Safe and Civil Schools' framework for proactive and positive classroom and behavior management, which aligns to Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) principles. Teachers will explore comprehensive and practical strategies to improve their current classroom management plan. These trainings are designed to help teachers manage student behavior more positively with the end result of engaging students in the learning process.
