Each participant....

- Must be a student in junior high or high school
- Will allowed to bring one female guest with them to the event
- Must attend the DTD event. Family members and/or friends cannot obtain the dress for you
- Must register to attend
- Must sign a photo release form
- Will receive one dress at the giveaway. Additional related accessories will be provided, if available

Here's what you can expect on the day of the Prom Dress Giveaway...

- The dresses are available on a first come, first serve basis
- Students will be required to check in upon arrival. Upon check-in they will be given a number. The number will determine the order in which they are able to shop. Girls who make a donation of \$10 or more will be given shopping preference and a special gift bag.
- Each girl will be assigned a personal stylist to assist with selecting a dress and accessories.
- Dress sizes and styles are subject to availability.
- Students will also be able to consult with hair stylist and make-up artist onsite.
- We will have drawings throughout the day for door prizes to include: gift certificates for additional items and services.

FAQs

What can I bring into the event?

We advise that you bring any foundational wear such (i.e. spanx) that you may wear under your dress. This will help in finding the perfect fit for your dream dress.

Do I have to bring my printed ticket to the event?

For faster registration, we ask that every student bring the printed copy or show the ticket on their electronic device if they registered via eventbrite.

Is it ok if the name on my ticket or registration doesn't match the person who attends?

No, the name on the ticket MUST match the name on your school ID. You may not have another student come in your place. Students must have their own ticket.

Do I have to register even if I don't want a dress?

Yes, every attendee must register.

Are there ID or minimum age requirements to enter the event?

Yes. Children must be at least 12 years of age to attend the event.
