PROMOTIONS PLAN

Nutrition Services' primary mission is to provide students with access to good food that is wholesome, simple, accessible, and locally sourced. POSTERS

Posters (attached) are available in two easily printable sizes — 8.5x11 and 11x17. Print them on a color printer and hang them around your school and in your cafeteria during the week of Oct. 8. Keep them up through the end of National School Lunch Week.

Add special messages to your morning announcements to remind students to go through the lunch line during National School Lunch Week. Messages can be included before and during National School Lunch Week. Sample messages:

- Today is the day! It's the start of National School Lunch Week! You won't want to miss the delicious and nutritious lunch items being served!
- Did you know Good Food fuels your body and helps you learn? Get some Good Food today in the cafeteria in celebration of National School Lunch Week!
- It's free sticker day in the cafeteria! Every student who goes through the lunch line will get a cool sticker today! Don't miss out! Eat good food and get a sticker!
- It's Friday! You know what that means? You have one more day to enjoy some of your favorite good foods in the cafeteria!

STICKERS

Rolls of "I ate Good Food today" stickers will be distributed via the Nutrition Services warehouse to all HISD elementary school cafeteria staff. Stickers can be distributed by cafeteria staff on the day of your choice during National School Lunch Week and should be handed out to all students who go through the lunch line on that day.
