- Teachers have **21** days to administer the assessment.
- It is **not** recommended to administer the entire assessment to a student in one seating. Administration of each subtest is approximately 3 minutes.
- It is recommended that the teacher allocates 2 hours per day for assessment administration. If this schedule is followed, all students will be assessed by Day 15.
- It is recommended to administer the assessment during workstation and/or center time.
- Campuses may support teachers during this time by utilizing paraprofessionals, parent helpers, or dedicated substitute teachers to support students in workstations while the teacher is assessing students one on one.
